





REMARKS BY RESIDENTS:

Frank Mucci addressed the Board stating that the left turn at Dunkin Donuts is a big hazard in the town. As soon as the Chief took office Mr. Mucci told him that there would be a big problem when CVS opened.

Trustee Cannella this is not a permanent decision. It was referred back to the police department for further deliberations, giving thought to traffic flow and to evaluate what happening now that CVS is opened. This can be revisited.

Mr. Mucci stated there is a problem there now. When the (no left turn) sign went up he and a patrolman watching and telling people there are no left turn. Residents said that they could not see the sign, it needed to be lowered. The next day the sign was taken down. People couldn't make the left turn out of CVS so turned around and made the left turn out of Dunkin Donuts. He suggested the handicap sign be moved to the front of the Post Office. The Chief told him that it could not be done because there is a hill.


